The Winds of Summer have certainly blown into The Dominion...I am sad to report that the high winds toppled or significantly damaged several of the mature trees throughout our property. However, I am happy to report with the exception of one majestic Live Oak on Hole 11 and a couple of strategically located trees on

holes 14, 15 and 16, most of the loss occurred outside the traditional boundaries of play. The Clubhouse was mostly unaffected by the high winds but the Swim and Tennis Centers did suffer some damage to their gazebos.

Many of you are aware that The Dominion has a new resident; a juvenile Caiman Crocodile has taken up residence in the water of Leon Creek between holes three and seven. The crocodile, when seen, has most often been spotted sunning itself of the weir at the lower end of the retention pond. Although no definitive determination has been made as to the retention of the crocodile, the San Antonio Game Warden was asked to inspect the crocodile's habitat to ensure it was appropriate to sustain the animal and sustainability was so determined! The Game Warden assured me that left alone (if not fed nor provoked) the animal would most likely not pose a significant threat to players or residents who respects its territory.

The best news of all...The Dominion is in great shape; the Golf Course is in excellent condition, the Swim Center and Cabana are open for business and the weather has been great for tennis. The hardest part is finding time to enjoy all that your Country Club has to offer!

All other players will be flighted by handicap and will play Stroke Play within their flight. Entry fee of \$95 per person includes scoreboard party Friday and Saturday and awards lunch buffet Sunday.
